

**2006 Jayson
Pinot Noir
Erin Green, Winemaker**

Tasting Notes:

The 2006 Jayson Pinot Noir is bright red in color. It has profuse scents of red currant and raspberry deepened by aromas of smoke and pancetta. Flavors of strawberries and mocha are balanced by spice and earth notes. This wine is approachable, juicy and creamy with a long lingering finish.

Winemaker's Notes:

Jayson is Pahlmeyer's second label; it is named after the proprietor, Jayson Pahlmeyer. After a meticulous selection process in assembling the final blend of the Pahlmeyer wine, winemaker Erin Green goes through the remaining lots and determines which, if any, are good enough to bottle under the Jayson label. Neither grapes nor juice are ever purchased to make any of the Jayson wines.
