

# **2007 Michael Pozzan Gold Series Pinot Noir Napa Valley**

## **Tasting Notes:**

This wine is an elegant, approachable Pinot Noir. It has subtle aromas of cherry and spice, with flavors of plum and dark fruit. The soft and supple tannins linger on your tongue in a long earthy finish. The winemaker says it will drink well over the next 4 years.

## **Winery History:**

Michael Pozzan Winery is owned and operated by Michael and Mary Ann Pozzan, both natives of California. Michael was born and raised in the San Francisco Bay Area, but spent his summer months with his grandparents on their 35 acre vineyard estate in Sonoma County. With roots extending to Piedmont, Italy, Michael's family still owns the original vineyard that his great-grandfather planted over 100 years ago. Learning from his family's experience and expertise, Michael has continued the family legacy of making wines of great quality. He founded his winery in 1991 and produces over 95,000 cases a year.
